

LOGGE SOUTHERN – PROJECT DATA SHEET

Project: Guy’s Hospital Blundell Wards Refurbishment
Client: Guy’s and St Thomas’ NHS Foundation Trust



This two phase project was completed in 2009. The work was carried out as part of the Contractors Framework with the Hospital Trust. It involved the complete refurbishment of the existing Blundell Wards to provide rooms and ward areas with ensuite facilities. The refurbishment included extensive Mechanical, Electrical and Public Health installations and alterations to existing services. The installation of new drainage was a

considerable challenge as most of the work had to be carried out from the floor below which was a live ward and could not be closed during the Blundell Ward work. To overcome this, the work was carried out over Christmas and New Year 2008/09 when the wards were at their quietest and access could be given by the Trust. Our plumbers and management worked every day except Christmas and New Years day to get the installation complete before the ward re-opened.



The wards were completely refitted including new ceilings, flooring, decorations, wall protection and IPS units for wc’s, showers and basins including infra red operating taps and flushes. New furniture was supplied and fitted and a new reception area and nurses station created. In addition to M&E new nurse call, access control, fire alarm and CCTV system were also provided and connected into the Trust’s existing systems.

This project was carried out adjacent to occupied areas and required close liaison and cooperation with users to ensure our work caused minimal disruption to patients or the users.
