

LODGE SOUTHERN – PROJECT DATA SHEET

Project: Guy's Old Dorcas Wards

Guy's Dorcas wards were refurbished and converted into a new Urology Department and support facilities. The 740M² of wards on the 6th floor of New Guy's House were stripped out and fully refitted in 2008. The work included extensive alterations and additions to the electrical installation including lighting, power, fire alarm, nurse call, access control and Patientline system. The existing plumbing, drainage and medical gases were altered to suit the new layout and existing split comfort cooling units relocated. New privacy partitions, doors

and screens, IPS and sanitaryware were installed, flooring and ceilings renewed and the entire area redecorated. A new main reception area and office facilities were also constructed as part of the project. Due to the urgent nature of the project we were appointed under the Contractors Framework and commenced work on site within 3 days of being appointed
